

Veterinary Technician (Part Time/Full Time)

Requirements:

Must be a licensed veterinary technician with a minimum of two years experience. Individual must feel comfortable working in a mobile clinic, and have a history of working in a high-pace, spay/neuter surgery environment. Requirement for said individual would be an emphasis on quality patient care. We are looking for someone with good teamwork abilities and a strong desire to enhance the welfare of animals.
